



Statement from Comal County Democratic Party Chair Victoria Locke

For immediate release

First and foremost, thank you to the New Braunfels Police Department for their thorough work on this investigation and for keeping us informed as it has progressed. NBPD's update confirms that the crash into our office over the July 4th weekend was not politically motivated. We're grateful no one was hurt.

We also want to thank this community. Since the incident, we've heard from neighbors across the political spectrum — Democrats, Republicans, and everyone in between — offering support, help with repairs, and simple words of concern. That response says more about who we are as a community than any damaged window ever could.

NBPD has found no evidence that our office was targeted because of who we are in this incident. We appreciate that clarity, and we take it seriously. At the same time, the damage was real, it disrupted our work, and repairs take real resources — none of that changes just because the cause was an accident. This is still an open matter as detectives continue to work the case.

We are already back at work. A building can be damaged. Our commitment to this community cannot be.
