



Neutrality Policy

Voters get to decide who they want to represent them during the election, and candidates for office deserve a fair primary. The Comal County Democratic Party (CCDP) will not endorse a candidate for office during the primary season if a primary is contested. We will promote candidates' events, repost candidates' social media statements, etc., but we will do so in an impartial manner.

As a courtesy, Democratic candidates may use the CCDP office for phone calls and other campaign work during the primary or election season. If there is a contested primary, then the CCDP will extend the same privilege to all candidates for that office.

We reserve the office for the CCDP meetings and business. Affiliated Democratic clubs including the Democrats of Comal County (DOCC), Democratic Women of Comal County (DWCC), and Young Democrats, may also hold meetings at the office. Other groups will not be permitted to use the office for meetings.

Office equipment, such as the copier and printer, is reserved only for use by the CCDP, DOCC, DWCC, or Young Democrats business. We understand that our members may also belong to other progressive or political groups, such as 50501, Indivisible, Mothers for Democracy (formerly Mothers Against Greg Abbott), the Texas Civil Rights Project, etc. Our members may not use our office equipment to produce materials for another group. To hold down costs, we are reserving it for CCDP, DOCC, DWCC, or Young Democrats business.

Postings for the event calendar or newsletter must be made in writing by the event host to comalcountyp@gmail.com. Throughout the primary season, the newsletter will feature only party events, campaign events, and events for our affiliated clubs.
