Voting Locations

1. REGISTER TO VOTE AND CHECK YOUR REGISTRATION

The last day to register or update your voter registration is **OCTOBER 5**. Visit **comaldemocrats.org** and look for VOTER INFORMATION.

- Is your address 100% correct?
- Is your voter status ACTIVE?
- Is your address listed in COMAL COUNTY?

If anything is incorrect, use the online form or call the County Elections Office at 830-221-1352.

2. FIND YOUR POLLING PLACE

Comal County registered voters may vote at any polling location in Comal County. Visit **votecomal.com** to view a list of voting locations and times.

3. PLAN TO VOTE EARLY

Don't wait until November 3! Avoid lines and last-minute delays by voting early from October 19 through October 30.

4. TELL A FRIEND

Remind your friends, colleagues, and family to vote. Better yet, offer them a ride!

5. VOTE FOR DEMOCRATS IN EVERY RACE

Bring this voter guide to the poll and an appropriate form of identification.

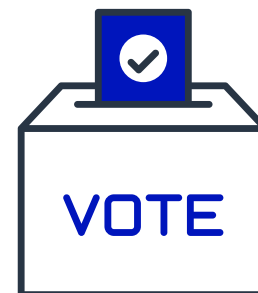
